CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Bristol is a leather with a traditional antique finish. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Fresh stains should be removed immediately using a soft cloth or paper towel, make sure it is not too wet to avoid water marks. Removing new stains immediately reduces the risk of permanent stains. Visible dirt and stains can be cleaned using a soft cloth and **Mild Leather Cleaner**. Be careful not to rub too hard. Always make sure to practice a test in a hidden area and be especially careful with lighter leather.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For maintenance, we recommend **Leather Protector**. It's a protective cream with the necessary moisturizing oils and UV protection. It protects the leather from fading and keeps it soft. Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
