CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Country is a high-quality, soft leather with a very fine finish. Due to the thin protective layer, this leather is pleasantly warm, but not too sensitive. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Stains can be cleaned with a damp terry cloth and **Mild Leather Cleaner**, make sure that it's not too wet to avoid water marks. Dry the darkened area with a hair dryer to avoid water marks. Always practice a cleaning test in a hidden area, be especially careful with lighter leather.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For regular treatment of aniline leather we recommend **Aniline Cream**. It prevents stains and dirt and keeps the leather soft and smooth.

Older leather and leather which is regularly exposed to sun or placed near a fireplace should additionally be treated with **Aniline Protector**. This treatment provides the necessary moisturizers for dry leather and prevents fading.

Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
