

Daytona is a smooth, dense, vacuum-dried leather, featuring a fine grain and a delicate aniline finish. This leather has a beautiful two-tone effect due to its natural finish. The oil finish means light scratches can be buffed out by hand.

CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Daytona is a saddle leather with a light pull-up effect. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Stains can be cleaned with a damp terry cloth and **Mild Leather Cleaner**, make sure that it's not too wet to avoid water marks. Always practice a cleaning test in a hidden area, be especially careful with lighter leather.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For maintenance, we recommend **Leather Protector**. It's a protective cream with the necessary moisturizing oils and UV protection. It protects the leather from fading and keeps it soft.

Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
