CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Highlight is a shiny leather with a metallic effect. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Fresh stains should be removed immediately using a soft cloth or paper towel. Removing new stains immediately reduces the risk of permanent stains. Be careful not to rub too hard. Clean remaining dirt and stains with **Mild Leather Cleaner**.

Visible dirt and stains can be cleaned using **Mild Leather Cleaner**. The **Leather brush** can additionally be used for dirty graining.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For maintenance, we recommend **Elephant Leather Preserver**. It keeps the leather soft and supple and maintains the slight shine. First rub the leather fat in a terry cloth and then apply thin layers.

Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
