CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Neck Puro is a pure aniline leather. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

In the case of fresh stains, first absorb with a dry terry cloth or paper towel by gently pressing with your fingers. Do not rub, this can change the surface irreversibly. Remaining spots can be cleaned with a damp terry cloth, make sure it's not too wet and do not rub too hard. Dry the darkened, wet area with a hair dryer with cold air to avoid water marks.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For maintenance, we recommend **Aniline Protector**. This treatment provides the necessary moisturizers to keep the leather soft and prevents fading.

Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
