CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Savanna is a slightly treated aniline leather. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Fresh stains should be removed immediately using a soft cloth or paper towel. Removing new stains immediately reduces the risk of permanent stains. Be careful not to rub too hard. Clean remaining dirt and stains with **Mild Leather Cleaner**.

Visible dirt and stains can be cleaned using **Mild Leather Cleaner**. The **Leather brush** can additionally be used for dirty graining.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For maintenance, we recommend **Leather Protector**. It's a protective cream with the necessary moisturizing oils and UV protection. It protects the leather from fading and keeps it soft. Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.

In high-traffic areas such as hotels, fast food restaurants, conference rooms, aircrafts or ships, the surface is more stressed and mechanical damages, color migration from jeans, and soiling on lighter leather occur more often. In such cases we recommend using **Leather Shield**, which provides a strong protection against wear, stains and color migration from jeans. **Leather Shield** should be applied after each cleaning or at least every two months to prolong the durability of the leather.

When both care products are used, the treatment with **Leather Shield** should always be applied before the treatment with **Leather Protector**. Let dry between the treatments.

Color damages caused by wear can be adjusted with **Leather Fresh**.
