Each hide is unique, the best Central European bull hides are shrunk in barrels following old techniques. During this complicated process, the leather loses up to 30 % of its surface area, but achieves a unique grain pattern with a beautiful crest effect, which makes for exciting storytelling, even in small leather goods. All Schrumpfleider is classically dyed through and then receives a pigment treatment on the grain side.

CLEAN & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

Schrumpflleder is a high quality, sturdy aniline leather. Aniline leather is warm, soft, open-pored smooth leather. Due to the open pores, these leathers are pleasantly warm, but also a little more sensitive to stains. Schrumpflleder is vegetable tanned and head-dyed. Due to the shrinkage and the special coloring, a very unique patina is created during use, which is characteristic of this type of leather through lighter and darker areas and emphasizes the beauty of this special type of leather. For everyday cleaning, it is sufficient to occasionally dust off the leather with a feather duster or a dry dust cloth.

Fresh stains should be removed immediately using a soft cloth or paper towel. Removing new stains immediately reduces the risk of permanent stains.

Visible dirt and stains can be cleaned using a damp terry cloth and **Mild Leather Cleaner**. Make sure that the cloth is not too wet. Dry the darkened area with a hair dryer with cold air to avoid watermarks. Always practice a cleaning test in a hidden area and be especially careful with lighter leather.

For difficult stains, we recommend to contact a specialist before taking any actions. Damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning attempts.

Maintenance and Treatments

For regular treatment of aniline leather we recommend **Aniline Cream**. It's a protective cream that prevents stains and dirt and keeps the leather soft and smooth.

Older leather and leather which is regularly exposed to sun or placed near a fireplace should additionally be treated with **Aniline Protector**. This treatment provides the necessary moisturizing for dry leather and prevents it from fading.

Depending on the strain, heat, and light intensity, the leather should be sparingly maintained every three to twelve months.
